

RSCDS Bristol Health and Safety Statement – Classes, Day Schools, Dances

Dancer responsibilities All Dancers attend Bristol Classes, Day Schools and/or Dances at their own risk.

Committee responsibilities The Committee of RSCDS Bristol will ensure that, as far as reasonably possible, risks associated with classes, the Day or Musicians School and Dances are mitigated. In particular, care will be taken to ensure that:

- A risk assessment is in place
- All electrical equipment used by Bristol RSCDS has been PAT tested within the last 12 months
- A First Aid kit is available (stored with the laptop)
- Action will be taken to reduce the risk of dancers slipping, slipstop will be used as allowed and required or a damp towel will be provided
- Dancers will be made aware of the fire procedures of the venue.

Teacher/MC/Host responsibilities

Should an accident occur at this event, it will be the responsibility of the Host to ensure that:

- an ambulance is called, as necessary
- an 'out-of-hours' contact for the specific venue is notified
- an entry is completed in the Bristol RSCDS accident book (stored with the laptop)
- any accident or incident is reported to the venue.
