Current Covid Precautions as at 22nd October 2021 are as follows:

You will understand that because we want to safeguard everyone in these strange times, there are some extra requirements. If you have any questions, do get in touch with me, tickets@rscdsbristol.info or other committee members.

Here they are:

- BAWA say that, “for the safety of your fellow members, guests and our staff, we encourage you to wear a mask where possible when moving around our venue.”
- We would like everyone to perform a lateral flow test no more than 24 hours before the event, ie that day or the evening before. (If you have not done one of these before – they are free from any pharmacy or online and are easy to do).
- If you have been double vaccinated and your test result is negative, you are free to dance without a mask.
- If you have been double vaccinated but are unwilling or unable to do a test, we ask that you wear a mask.
- If you have not been vaccinated and your test is negative, we ask that you still wear a mask.

NB

If your test is positive or you have symptoms of Covid – please do not attend on this occasion.

If you have not been vaccinated and have not been able or willing to take a test - please do not attend.

We will keep the hall well ventilated. Please use hand sanitiser, which will be provided, between dances. If you can bring your own preferred sanitiser, this would be appreciated.
