## **Covid requirements at St Peters are as follows:**

You will understand that because we want to safeguard everyone in these strange times, there are some extra rules. If you have any questions, do get in touch with me, [tickets@rscdsbristol.info](mailto:tickets@rscdsbristol.info) or other committee members.

Here they are!

We would like everyone to perform a lateral flow test no more than 24 hours before the Dance ie that day or the evening before (Note 1). Depending on your circumstances the table below sets out how we would like you to act.

Lateral flow test	Vaccinated in line with the latest government guidelines	NOT Vaccinated in line with the latest government guidelines
Negative	<b>OK to dance mask free</b>	<b>Please wear a mask</b>
Unable/Unwilling to test	<b>Please wear a mask</b>	<b>Please do not attend</b>
Positive	<b>Please do not attend</b>	<b>Please do not attend</b>

### **NB**

If have symptoms of Covid, regardless of your result – **please do not attend.**

We will keep doors and windows open to ventilate the Hall. Please use sanitizer on your hands between dances and bring your own water to make it easier for you to identify your drink and keep everyone safe. Water jugs will be provided for refills and compostable cups for those who forget their water bottles. We will have a “one in, one out” rule for the toilets.

There is no knowing what the rules might be on the day, and they may be markedly different, either way, but please be prepared to comply with these requirements. You will be advised of any changes should this be necessary.

**Note 1** If you are not familiar with the latest Lateral Flow Tests (ordered online for home delivery Nov 2021) throat swabs are no longer required (hurrah!) and results are available in 15 minutes. They are now easy to do.

Note that to collect a pack of tests from a Pharmacy you now require a collect code <https://test-for-coronavirus.service.gov.uk/collect-lateral-flow-kits>

You can also get a collect code by calling 119 (free from landlines and mobiles).

Lines are open from 7am to 11pm.

Tests are provided in packs of 7, you can share a test pack as you supply the code from the test strip when reporting the result.
